Norco College Logistics Management program can help you advance your career in distribution, warehousing, transportation, procurement and logistics as an analyst, supervisor or manager. Entry level manager salaries range from \$40,000 to \$45,000 and can advance to \$72,000 to \$97,000 annually.



Graduates work for retailers, manufacturers, parcel carriers, agricultural firms and third party logistics companies. Students are hired by large firms that distribute products nationally and globally such as UPS, FedEx, Target, Wal-Mart, Nike, Converse, Albertson's, Schneider Logistics and CEVA Logistics.
